6. CONSENT AGENDA

m. Consideration to award a purchase contract through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative to Kunes Country Ford of Antioch, IL for a 2021 Ford Explorer 4-door vehicle in the amount of \$36,679 from the Capital Replacement Fund.

(The Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) represents over 100 municipalities throughout the region and joint bid the Ford Explorer with Kunes Country Ford providing the lowest competitive bid price.

(While the vehicle is ordered now, it will not be available until summer in the FY 2021-22 budget.

(Sufficient funds were budgeted and are available for the purchase.)

- n. Consideration of the following:
 - To reject the bid held on February 25, 2021 for the Landscape Improvements -Biesterfield Road (Rohlwing to Cutter) project due to clarity issues in the original bid; and
 - To award a professional service contract for the bid held on Thursday, March 18, 2021, to the most responsive and responsible bidder Semper Fi Land Services, Inc. of Aurora, IL for the Landscape Improvements Biesterfield Road (Rohlwing to Cutter) in the amount of \$213,632.15 from the Capital Projects Fund.

(On Thursday, February 25, 2021 the Village opened sealed bids for the Landscape Improvements - Biesterfield Road (Rohlwing to Cutter) project.

(A total of eight (8) contractors obtained contract documents, with six (6) submitting bids. (The engineer's estimate for the project was \$247,607.00. The lowest bid was \$177,116.40 and the highest bid was \$1,343,274.00.

(A subsequent review of the total bid tabulation showed a wide disparity in the total bid prices across those bids received. Of the six total bids received, four of the bids had made errors on one or more of the bid line items. Of the two remaining bids, the lower bid of \$323,197 was 26% higher than the engineer's estimate of \$247,607.

(Due to the numerous errors and the lowest bid being significantly over the engineer's estimate, the decision was made to reject all bids.

(The Village re-posted the project to include a Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting.

(On Thursday, March 18, 2021 the Village opened sealed bids for the re-posted Landscape Improvements - Biesterfield Road (Rohlwing to Cutter) project.

(A total of three (3) contractors submitted bids.

(The lowest bid was received from Semper Fi Land Services, Inc. of Aurora, IL in the amount of \$213,632.15.

(Adequate funds are available in the Capital Project Fund Fund.

(The Director of Public Works recommends approval.)

o. Consideration to adopt Ordinance No. 3700 amending Title 3, Chapter 3, Section 3-3-7, Number of Licenses of the Village Code of the Village of Elk Grove Village by increasing the Number of Class "A" Liquor Licenses.

(This Ordinance increases the Class "A" Liquor Licenses from thirty-six (36) to thirty-seven (37).)

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and other applicable Federal and State laws, the meeting will be accessible to individuals with disabilities.
