### **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS - Application Form and One-Page Essay**

The scholarship will be awarded to the applicants who, in the opinion of the judges, best demonstrate this spirit of leadership and volunteerism.

- Attach a one-page essay demonstrating the applicant's leadership/volunteerism.
