

SPRAYBOOTH CHECKLIST

PERMIT APPLICATION & SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Ш	Complete a building permit application online by visiting our <u>Online Permitting Portal</u>
	Electrical contractor shall provide a letter of intent and a copy of their electrical license.
	Roofing contractor shall provide a copy of the state roofing license (if applicable).
	All other contractors must obtain a Village Contractors license prior to issuance of permit (No insurance or
	bond required).
	Provide cut sheets and specifications on the spray booth
	Spray booths require both a fire suppression system and fire alarm system. Separate fire permit applications
	must be submitted for that work. Spray booth suppression and fire alarm must be connected to the tenant
	spaces fire alarm system. The existing fire alarm system must be in accordance with current EGV
	Municipal Ordinances otherwise a fire alarm system upgrade will be required.
	Submit plans that indicate the following:
	 Floor plan layout identifying the location of the spray booth
	 Dimensions of exhaust outlets to site property lines
	 Exhaust discharge location and separation from air intakes and other roof penetrations
	 Make up air system providing an equivalent amount of air being exhausted
	 Quantity and type of hazardous materials intended to be stored on site
	 Electrical raceway, disconnect and panel details/locations
	Must comply with the following codes:

	 2021 International Energy Conservation Code w/ Illinois and EGV Amendments
	o 2023 National Electrical Code
